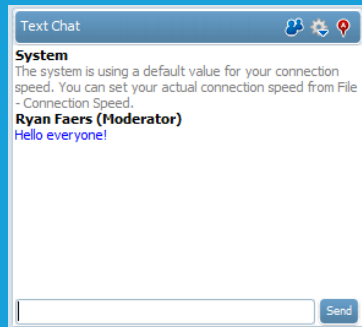

He went to prison for 27 years for fighting against the government
and their unfair treatment of black people.

The story of Nelson Mandela

Problems in South Africa

Most South African people are black but there are also many white people who live there too.

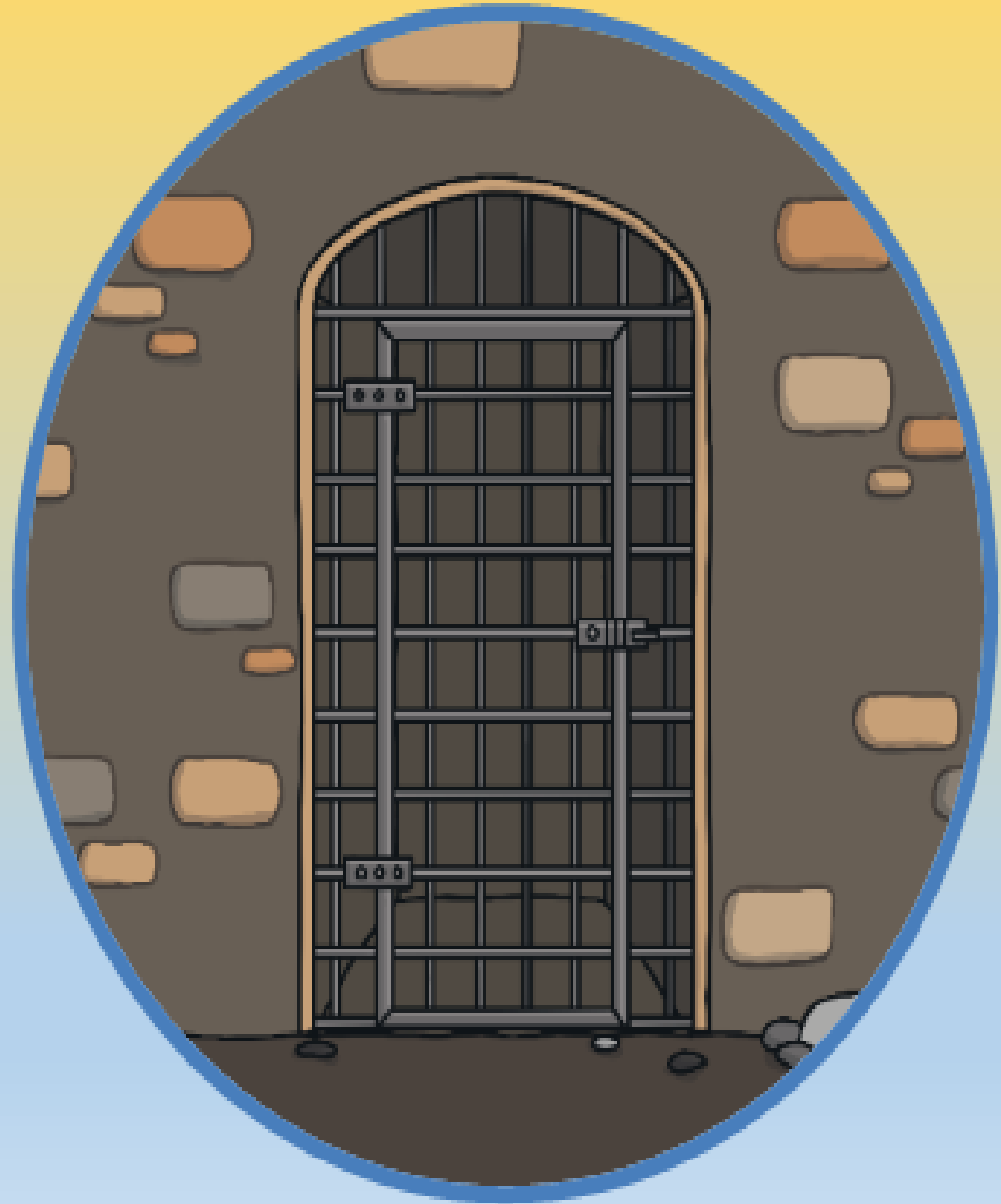
White and black people spent years fighting over land. In 1944, Nelson Mandela joined a protest group because he wanted change.



The story of Nelson Mandela

He wanted black South Africans to have the same rights as white South Africans.

In 1956, Mandela and 155 other people were arrested and Mandela went to prison for 5 years.



The story of Nelson Mandela

In 1962, Mandela was arrested again and was given a life sentence. He spent the next 18 years in Robben Island prison before being moved to a different prison for another 9 years.

Mandela became the most famous prisoner in the whole world. People around the world were calling 'Free Nelson Mandela!' In 1990, South Africa's president FW de Klerk finally set Nelson Mandela free. Mandela and Klerk agreed there was to be no more fighting. Mandela called to all South African people to live together in peace.



The story of Nelson Mandela

In 1933 Nelson Mandela was awarded the Nobel Peace prize.



Archbishop Desmond Tutu (another famous South African) and Nelson Mandela called South Africa a 'rainbow nation' because people of all races and skin colours were working together.

Nelson Mandela wanted change in South Africa. We will also be thinking about what we might like to change about the area we live in.

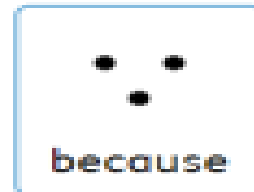
