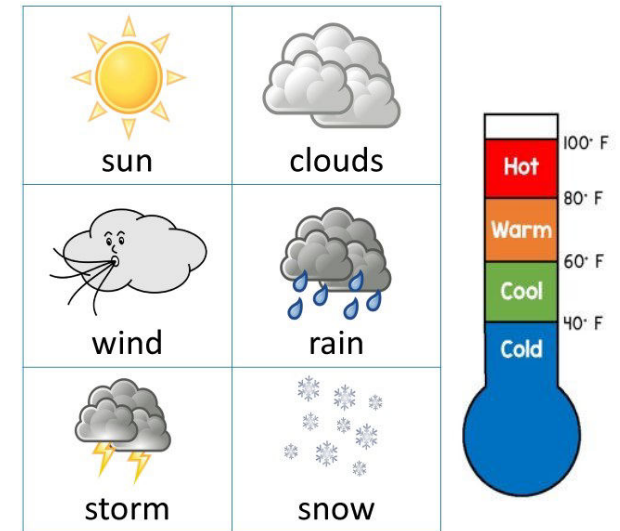
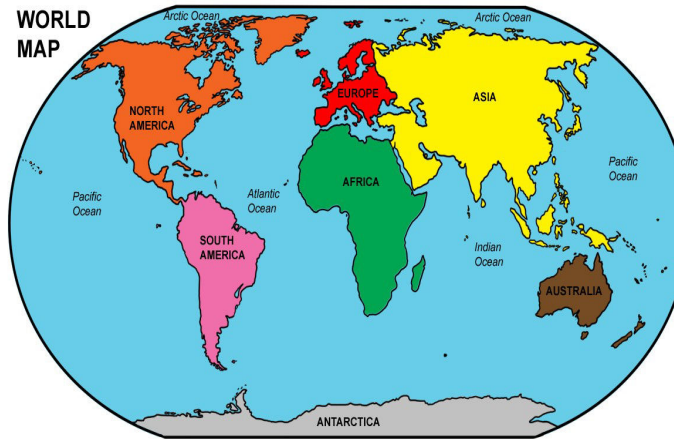

Our learning

In our geography lessons this term we are learning to name and **locate** the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will learn about hot and cold climates and how to identify different climates based on the **environment**.



Information

There are seven continents on Earth: Asia, Europe, Africa, North America, South America, Australia and Antarctica.

The five oceans are the Pacific Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean, the Indian Ocean, the Arctic Ocean and the Southern Ocean.

The North Pole is the point that is farthest north on the planet Earth and the South Pole is located in Antarctica.

The UK is in Europe.

Vocabulary

World - the earth or globe, considered as a planet.

Equator - the Equator is an imaginary circle around Earth that is half-way between the North and South Poles

Climate - the usual weather conditions in a particular area.

Continent - a large area of land made up of different countries. The area is usually a large expanse of land but can be formed of many island countries.

Ocean - a huge area of salt water. Oceans cover nearly 71 percent of Earth's surface.

Weather - is sunshine, rain, snow, wind, and storms.

Temperature - is the measure of the warmth or coldness in the air
