

#### Dear Parent / Carer,

We use an online platform called Maths with Parents for our home learning in maths. This is designed to help whole families discover the fun in maths together. You may be new to this or already registered last year. Please see the following instructions that hopefully cover all of your questions regarding registration this year.

# Are you a new parent who hasn't used MwP before?

- 1. Visit www.mathswithparents.com
- 2. Click 'Log In', then 'New Parent'
- 3. Enter your child's class code:

# Do you have more than one child at the school?


- 1. Log in to your account.
- 2. At the bottom of your page there is a 'Add another child' icon. Click this button.
- 3. Enter your other child's class code
- 4. Enter their name, and then click 'Confirm'

# I registered last year – how can I move my child to their new class?

- 1. Log in with your existing username & password
- 2. You will see your child's Mathscot. When you click on this, the website will give you a list of classes in your child's year. Select your child's new class. (Note: You will not have to enter the new code)

### Forgotten your password?

Click on the forgotten password button and enter your email address to be sent a new fourdigit password. If you want to reset your password, once you have logged in you can click on the 'account' menu and choose a more memorable word.

## Can more than one parent register for their child?

Yes. Each parent can register individually. As long as you have the correct class code and all parents spell the child's name in the same way, you can all have access to your child's profile. You could also add grandparents or other carers, to get the whole family involved in maths!

#### How does the Child Reward Scheme work?

We have a child reward scheme where you earn stars for watching the videos and leaving comments. The more topics you complete, the more clothes your mathscot will be wearing! Children will be given certificates for all of the different topics they complete, so don't forget to watch the videos, do the activities, and leave comments in both of the boxes!

### There aren't any activities, only an intro video. Why is that?

Your first topic hasn't been released yet. Don't worry, you will receive an email when the first topic is released.

## I can't see any activities under the video. Why is that?

When a new video is sent out, the activities won't appear until a video has been watched. Once you have watched the video the activities should appear at the bottom.
