

#### **Ole Kirk Christiansen**

**Summer 2 Week 7 CAW Quality of the Week: Excellence** 

Danish Carpenter and founder of Lego (7<sup>th</sup> April 1932 - 11<sup>th</sup> March 1958)

In 1932, Ole Kirk Christiansen (one of 13 siblings) transformed his small woodworking shop (which initially sold household products) into a wooden toy manufacture. The business was nearly destroyed in 1924 when Christiansen's sons accidentally caused a fire which burned down the workshop and home. Luckily, Christiansen took this as motivation to expand his business and developed into making plastic toys, including Lego, in 1947. This was really challenging for Christiansen as he'd only worked with wood his whole life. He had to be super creative and resilient to solve problems and develop his product! His demonstration of all the CAW qualities have led to him creating an **excellent** brand that is played with by children all over the world!


