





Author, campaigner and lecturer

Born in Alabama, USA in 1880, Helen Keller made an incredible impact on the world. Before she turned two years old, an illness meant that she lost both her sight and her hearing. This did not stop her showing incredible amounts of **ASPIRATION**, and she went on to campaign for rights for disabled people and for women to have the right to vote. She wrote 14 books in her lifetime, and hundreds of essays and lectures. A truly inspirational person and an incredible role model.

### Our aims at City Academy Whitehawk are to:


- 1. Raise awareness of environmental issues through weekly class assemblies
