PE Kit Policy at City Academy Whitehawk



Children are expected to bring a PE kit for their 2 hourly sessions each week. Please see below City Academy Whitehawk's new PE kit policy.

Indoor PE

Children are required to wear a blue CAW t-shirt, black shorts and plimsolls/trainers. During dance and gymnastics children will often be required to be barefoot. Children with verrucas must wear a plaster or plimsolls. They must remove watches and ALL jewellery for PE and games. Earrings must be removed for PE or covered with tape from the office.

Outdoor PE

The same PE kit and health and safety protocols must be adhered to, except that children may wear a jumper and jogging/tracksuit bottoms (blue or black) when it is cold.

No PE Kit

If pupils bring in their PE kit they will be rewarded 1 learning ticket as per the school behaviour reward system. Pupils who do not bring in PE kit will be noted, and if this happens 3 weeks in a row, parents will be contacted regarding this. Pupils who do not bring in PE kit may need to wear spare PE kit provided.

Non-participation

Pupils who are not able to participate in PE due to illness or injury will be excused from PE if:

- A written letter addressed to the teacher/ PE specialist teacher from the parent/carer is given prior to the lesson, which details the reason why the pupil cannot participate.
- The office is phoned explaining the reasons why the pupil cannot participate.
