# Lion Mane Peppers and Houmous

Ingredients: bag of peppers, chives, pot of humous, olives and mozzarella or cheddar (or edible eyes)



Put a pot of houmous (or another dip your child likes) in the centre of large plate. Slice orange, red and yellow peppers cutting into a point at the end. Carve a heart out of a piece of red pepper. The rest of the lion's face is made of three extra-large olives (two for eyes and one for the mouth), a small amount of mozzarella for the whites of the eyes and some fresh chives for his whiskers.

# Funny Frog Sandwiches

Ingredients: bread, ham, cheese optional, cucumber, raisins or olives, grapes



Use a cookie cutter (or an upturned cup) to cut out circles of bread. Do the same for the ham and cheese. Cut some long strips out of the ham and roll the ends to make it look like a curled tongue. Add a raisin or olive to make it look like the frog is catching a bug! Cut triangles out of cucumber for the webbed feet. Cut a grape in half to make the eyes and add a little bit of black olive for the pupils.

### Tropical Turtles

Ingredients: kiwi, grapes, edible eyes or cheese and olives



Peel and slice a kiwi for the body. Cut a grape in half down the middle for the head. For the feet, make sure you cut just the tips of the grapes. #### Bear Paw Cookies

Ingredients: cookies, chocolate buttons

Melt a small amount of chocolate and use this as glue. Place one chocolate button in the centre for the paw and 4, standing upright, for the claws.
