- The continent of Asia is so large and diverse that it is often divided into six subregions. This means that different parts of Asia belong to a separately named area.
 This would help with giving weather forecasts, having governments and health services.
- Asia is rich in diverse races, cultures, and languages.
- Many of the world's major religions came out of Asia including Christianity,
 Judaism, Islam, Hinduism, and Buddhism.
- Countries such as Russia, China, Japan and India produce products and services that are used by every nation in the world.






