Please do read through this week's bulletin to keep up to date with our school information.



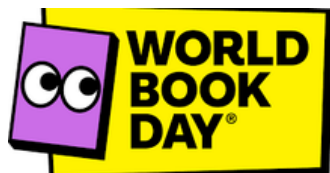

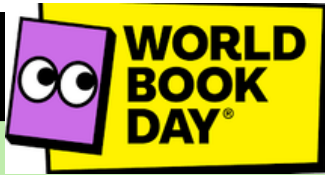
